

## Wheat Receipts Continue Big While Export Demand is Poor

Chicago Market Rules Heavy Throat and Lower Prices are Recorded—Winnipeg Exchange Stronger.

World Office, Wednesday Evening, Aug. 17. Liverpool wheat futures closed to-day unchanged to 1/4 higher than yesterday; corn futures 1/4 higher. September wheat at Chicago closed 1/4 lower than yesterday, Sept. corn 1/4 lower, and Sept. oats 1/4 lower. October wheat at Winnipeg closed 1/4 higher than yesterday, October oats 1/4 higher. Chicago car lots to-day: Wheat, 448; contract, 289. Corn, 117. Oats, 274. 743. Northwest wheat receipts to-day were 75 cars, against 355 a week ago and 21 a year ago. Winnipeg receipts of wheat to-day were 15 cars, against 50 a week ago and 6 a year ago.

Four acres of oat on Tuesday night sent the western wheat prices up yesterday 1/4, in spite of lower cables from Liverpool. Caruthers & Co. say the frost may do some damage to the oats, but harvesting is too far advanced to injure the wheat to any extent. The latest report estimates the total at 50,000,000 bushels. Richardson & Co. are very pleased with the way the crop is turning out. Harvesting has become general, and should be completed within a week or two. The C. N. R. crop report for the past week announces that the harvesting is in full swing all along their lines, and that the crops are very much better than expected. Harvesters are urgently needed.

Cold Storage for Fruit Shipments. J. A. Riddick, Dominion Cold Storage Commissioner, is in the city arranging for the shipment of early apples and the more tender fruit to Great Britain under new and especially favorable conditions. Cold storage reservations have been made on steamers sailing for Glasgow, London, Liverpool and Bristol, on Sept. 17 and 24 and Oct. 1, while one leave for Glasgow on Sept. 18. Ice cars will carry the fruit to the steamer. Mr. Riddick will also show several members of Lord Brassey's party thru the Niagara district.
