SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL.

FRIDAY, July 14th, 1893.

The following recommendations of the Executive Committee were read and ordered to be carried into effect:

- (1) That the matches open on Tuesday, August 22nd.
- (2) That the services of two Range officers be secured.
- (3) That the “Provincial” match be omitted from the Grand Aggregate and made a Martini-Henri competition at Queens' Ranges, seven shots; the York and Kings Pitcher to be incorporated with it as a prize for Regimental Teams of five.
- (4) That the 500 and 600 yard scores in the “Provincial” match be included in the aggregate for the Governor General's medals, and the “All Comers” match omitted.
- (5) That the first and second cash prizes in the Prince of Wales match be reversed.

In view of the introduction of the time system of squadding, it was decided that entries, accompanied by the fees, be made on or before Friday, August 18th, and that twenty per cent be charged on all post entries.
