ALL CHURCHES MUST CLOSE. (Bangor Commercial.) There has been no modification of the order of the Bangor board of health closing the churches, schools, theatres and all other places of public gathering and there will be none until the danger of an influenza epidemic here is over, according to Dr. D. A. Robinson, chairman of the board, in a statement made Friday afternoon. The fact that services were held Friday morning in the Catholic churches of the city has caused many to believe that the ban had been lifted. Asked if the church had been permitted to hold these services Friday, Dr. Robinson stated that the board of health had made and would make no exceptions to its original order, and that the services were held in direct violation of the order. Father Brown of St. John's church stated to a reporter that he had not understood that the matter of closing the churches had been definitely settled, having received no official notification of the health board's order other than that appearing in the newspapers. He said the church had no desire to oppose the action of the city officials.
