

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION.

Students who do not desire the license of either the Quebec or Ontario College of Physicians and Surgeons will be examined by this University on the following subjects. Fee \$4.00.

COMPULSORY SUBJECTS : English, French, Latin, Arithmetic, Algebra, Euclid, History, Geography, Belles-lettres.

OPTIONAL SUBJECTS [Candidates can select any one of the following subjects] : Greek, Natural and Moral Philosophy.

The preliminary examinations of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Quebec are held at Montreal in the month of May and at Quebec in September. Fee for this examination—ten dollars. Should the candidate be unsuccessful, one half the fee will be returned. For more complete details address either of the Secretaries, Dr. F. W. Campbell, Montreal, or Dr. A. G. Belleau, Quebec. SUGGESTIONS TO STUDENTS.

Although out of the four years' study only three sessions are required to be spent at College, it is advisable that the entire period of four years be devoted to attendance on lectures during session, in which case the student is recommended to attend as follows (paying special attention to Practical Anatomy during the first two years) :

FIRST YEAR.

ANATOMY, PRACTICAL ANATOMY, PHYSIOLOGY, MATERIA MEDICA, CHEMISTRY, HISTOLOGY, BOTANY, HYGIENE and HOSPITAL PRACTICE.

Students are at liberty to present themselves for examination on Botany, Histology and Hygiene, at the end of their first session.

SECOND YEAR.

ANATOMY, PHYSIOLOGY, MATERIA MEDICA, CHEMISTRY, PRACTICAL CHEMISTRY, OBSTETRICS, DISSECTION, HOSPITAL PRACTICE AND CLINICS.

Students who have passed their Examination on Botany, Histology and Hygiene, and have attended two complete courses on any of the primary subjects, may be admitted to examination on these subjects at the end of their second year. This plan is recommended to Students taking four years attendance at College.
