Montréal, 24.—Son Excellence Mgr Pietro di Maria, délégué apostolique au Canada et à Terre-Neuve sera à la tête de la forte délégation Canadienne qui se rendra à Chicago, en juin prochain, pour le congrès Eucharistique, annonce le R. P. V. Primeau, président du comité de réception du congrès qui était de passage à Montréal hier après-midi.

Le R. P. Primeau est venu conférer avec M. H. H. Melanson, gérant général du service des voyageurs au Chemin de Fer National du Canada au sujet du voyage à Chicago de son Excellence. Le délégué apostolique et celui des autres personnalités ecclésiastiques qui se rendront aux

grandes fêtes eucharistiques. Mgr Pietro di Maria fera le voyage dans une voiture spéciale par le Chemin de Fer National du Canada, S. G. Mgr Gauthier, archevêque de Montréal, S. G. Mgr A. E. Deschamps, évêque auxiliaire et Mgr A. V. J. Piette recteur de l'université de Montréal se rendront ensuite aussi à Chicago par le même réseau.

"L'intérêt soulevé par le congrès eucharistique et l'empressement des Canadiens à signifier leur intention de s'y rendre sont des signes très encourageants", a déclaré le R. P. Primeau, qui a ajouté, "après les États-Unis, c'est le Canada qui enverra la plus forte délégation à Chicago. Le chemin de fer national du Canada a lui seul s'est déjà vu retenir vingt trains spéciaux pour le transport des milliers canadiens. Il transportera des groupes de toutes les parties du Canada, de l'Atlantique aux rochers et de plus un groupe de l'Alaska qui sous la direction de S. G. Mgr Crimont, évêque de Jumeau, fera le voyage en bateau à Chicago par le chemin de fer national du Canada. Naturellement la plus grosse délégation partira de Québec, mais de forts groupes partiront des provinces des prairies.
