LA FRANC-MACONNERIE SUR LA SELLETTE AU CONSEIL DE BERNE

Berne, 24.—Au Grand Conseil de Berne, un député catholique, M. Boisay, a demandé au gouvernement de consigner aux agents de la police la Loge maçonnique "Union", qui compte, paraît-il, un certain nombre d'adhérents dans le Jura bernois.

Ces "Petits Frères", a-t-il dit, ne sont pas indépendants, ils doivent à l'obéissance complète à l'Association secrète qui leur interdit, par exemple, de déposer contre leurs frères. D'où nombre de faux témoignages, dont la population catholique du Jura est souvent la victime.

Le directeur de la police cantonale a contesté que les statuts de l'Union puissent influencer l'impartialité des policiers, mais le gouvernement a promis d'examiner les cas portés à sa connaissance.

La discussion, qui a été de plus vives, a tourné, en définitive, à l'avantage du député catholique.

Il faut du courage pour s'attaquer à l'action maçonnique. Les francs-maçons ne sont qu'un poignée, mais par leurs menées souterraines, ils se rendent redoutables.

UN "REQUIEM" ANGLICAN POUR LE CARDINAL MERCIER

L'église anglicaine a eu la piété de rendre hommage à la mémoire du cardinal Mercier, et la cathédrale de Cantorbéry, à la première, à fin d'un office du matin, célébré une messe, mais bien significative commémoration de l'archevêque de Malines, sans aucun doute sur l'avis de l'archevêque de Cantorbéry, absent.

Mais il a été célébrée une cérémonie de plus d'apparat dans l'église de Saint-Magnus-le-Martyr, à Londres. On avait dressé devant le sanctuaire un catafalque, entouré de six chiers et, sur le catafalque, posé barrette cardinalice. Le service fut célébré par un parteur, avec diacre et sous-di-

tre. Des cierges furent distribués à l'assistance, cierge qu'on alluma pour la lecture de l'Évangile, pour la consécration, et pour l'absolution. On aurait pu se croire, à ne considérer que ce ritualisme, dans une église catholique romaine, où tout chez des anglicans.

Une brève oraison funèbre fut prononcée par C. Core, aïeuné évêque d'Oxford, un des cinq anglicans qui prirent part naguère aux conversations de Malines, et qu'il prononça, avec pour texte la parole biblique: A great priest.

Mgr Crimont, évêque de Juneau, fera le voyage en bateau à Chicago par le chemin de fer national du Canada. Naturellement la plus grosse délégation partira de Québec, mais de forts groupes partent des provinces des prairies.

Le Canada aura des porte-parole aux assemblées internationales", dit le R. P. Primeau, et c'est un grand honneur, S. G. Mgr Gauthier qui sera à la tête du groupe français à Chicago en sera.
