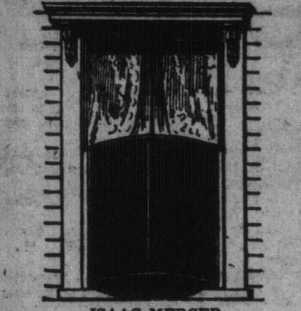

# BRILLIANT WORK BY CANADIANS

## Boys Bump Into No Less Than

Thirty-One Enemy Divi-  
sions—Occupy Line of Ca-  
nal Du Nord.

With the Canadian Forces, Sept.  
5.—(By J. F. B. Livesey, Correspond-  
ent of The Canadian Press)—Some  
very brilliant battle tactics were pulled  
off during the recent engagements  
of individual brigades and battalions.  
Since August 3 the Canadian corps  
have bumped into no less than thirty-  
one enemy divisions, a number of  
which have been put completely out  
of action for the time being. It met  
as many as fifteen divisions in the  
fighting of the past week.

Its success is accounted for, not  
alone by the valor and tenacity of the  
individual soldiers, but by a high  
standard of leadership throughout all  
ranks.

Through Scarred Belt.  
Yesterday the Canadian troops oc-  
cupied the line of the Canal Du Nord  
and pushed strong patrols east  
through the line of Olay Le Verger  
and Marguon. The Canadian corps  
has now penetrated through the bat-  
tle stricken belt and is again in coun-  
try that shows little of the devastat-  
ion of war. The Hun left it too  
quickly to destroy it, but he is shel-  
ling with heavy guns. The villages,  
which, until now have escaped, will  
soon be reduced to heaps of tumbled  
brick and mortar. Such a village is  
Ecourt.

On Sunday night the population of  
this village was evacuated by the  
enemy but forty-eight persons, mostly  
old men and women, remained hid-  
den in their cellars and gave an en-  
thusiastic welcome to the British  
troops who released them after four  
years of slavery. They have been set  
free, but the women have been  
telling in the trenches.
