I have the honour to report that on or about April 13th, last, after discussing the matter with you and receiving your approval, I authorized the installation of a pumping plant at the Kamloops Industrial School for the purpose of irrigating 100 acres of land.

The work has been done and the agent reports that the plant is a signal success; that the 100 acres of school land can now be cultivated easily and made productive.

According to Orders in Council your approval is required by the War Purchasing Commission of all items of expenditure over \$500.00.

I have to report that the cost of machinery and other material for this plant is as follows:-
