An Act to explain the Act respecting Railways.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the construction of the eightieth Preamble. section of the Act, chapter sixty-six of the Consolidated Statutes of Janada, respecting Railways:

For the removal of such doubts, Her Majesty, by and with the ad-5 vice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

II. The said eightieth section shall be read and construed with the Proviso addfollowing proviso, and as if the same had been enacted therewith, that of c. 66, Con.
is to say:—"Provided always, that no shareholder who is also a creditor Stat. Can.
10 of the Company shall be liable under this section, unless the amount Liability of
in which the Company is indebted to him shall fall short of the amount
unpaid on the stock held by him, and then he shall only be liable for
the difference."
