Albany 20th Augustus 1720

Whereas his Ex^{ty} Governour Montgomerie has been Pleas'd to write a l^{tr} to us the Comissioners Directing us to acquaint the Six nations of Ind^{ns} by you to meet him this Governour here the first Day of October next this is therefore to order you forthwith to Summon the said Nations of Indians to be punctually here on 1st Day of October

Albany 20th August 1720

May it Please y^r Ex^{ty}

We Received his Excellency's Letter of the 14th August yesterday and in obedience there to have this day Dispatched Lawrence Clasen to Summon the Six nations of Indians to be punctually here on the 1st of Oct^{ber} next according to the Ex^{ty} Directed have ordered him to come down 10th an we 10th Respects May it please your Excellency
