	13-5-42		Overcast. At 2300 hours, Harvard MK 11, 3044 piloted by R130122 LAC Cummins, W.E., tipped up on nose at Main Aerodrome after pilot had applied brakes too harshly in attempting to correct a swing on landing. Pilot uninjured. The Ottawa Drama League Revue presented a performance in the Recreation Hall in the evening, with a large number of airmen and airwomen present.		
	14-5-42		Low clouds, fog, clearing in afternoon. The Commanding Officer's weekly parade was held at 0745 hours. United States personnel, both airmen and Officers (13 Officers and 56 airmen) went before the Joint Canadian-American Board for interview. These airmen and Officers had made application for transfer to the United States forces.		
	15-5-42		Overcast, with intermittent showers. Very little flying.		
	16-5-42		Overcast, intermittent showers. Poor weather again cut down the flying hours.
