

VI.-Conclusion.

The United States counter-draft is acceptable and it seems that we should proceed at once with informing the United States Government that we are also prepared to sign.

In his note, transmitting the United States counter-draft, the United States chargé d'affaires says that he has power to sign the Convention. Signature, therefore, may take place at Ottawa, unless there is any objection.
