



Ottawa, Nov. 17th., 1908.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant enclosing the notes given by Emmanuel College to Messrs. MacKenzie & MacInnes. Since writing you on the 21st. of October the Department has received another account from MacKenzie & MacInnes showing a balance of \$39.72. As this does not agree with the amount shown by the previous account, certified by you, namely, \$45.11, it is thought well to send you both accounts in order that you may adjust the difference. It may be that the accounts refer to different claims, but if so, the facts can be readily ascertained. The deduction of \$1.97 referred to in letter of 21st October, should be made from the amount found to be due MacKenzie & MacInnes.
