Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of September 27th, 1946, reference No. P 1474-2-2-4-1-2-2 enclosing a report from Sgt. H.K. Rhodes, I/G Churchill Detachment and Churchill No. 5 and York Factory 1946 Annual by paylists. These paylists have been checked and my request that in due course the following points be reported upon.

YORK FACTORY BARR

- No. 30 - Please advise why girl was transferred to No. 225.
- No. 36 - The 1945 paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 4 boys and 2 girls while this paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 2 boys and 4 girls.
- No. 225 - Please advise why girl was transferred to this number from No. 68.
- No. 224 - Please advise why girl was transferred to this number from No. 79.

No. 99 - The 1945 paylist shows only 1 man on this date while this paylist shows one deceased "Booth" - "Woman died in 1940".

No. 115 - The "Number on previous paylist" is 0 not 1 as this woman's name did not appear on the 1945 paylist.

No. 129 - The 1945 paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 4 girls while this paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 5 girls with one deceased "Hitch" - "Boy born July 16th, 1943" and one deceased "War Cause" - "Boy married, transferred to No. 221". If the 1945 paylist is correct should the 1946 paylist not show 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 4 girls.
