
Ottawa, 2nd December, 1902-

Sir,

I have to request that you will be good enough to notify Jean Bte. Paul, owner of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Lot 1, Range 1, Quiatchouan, and Stainslas Paul, owner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Lot 2, Range 1, in the same Township, Sales 22 & 23, that they will be allowed three months in which to pay a fair portion of the purchase money and interest against their properties, failing which, the Department will, in the interests of the Indians, have to cancel the Sales, and dispose of the lands to other purchasers.

At the expiration of the time, you will be careful to report promptly to the Department, and state what action these parties have taken in the matter, and whether you would then recommend cancellation of either or both of the Sales.
