
Ottawa, November 15, 1919.

Reverend Sir,-

The Department is in receipt of Inspector MacKinnon's report on the Whyccomagh Indian Day School and regrets to say that the progress and general conditions at this school are far from satisfactory. The attendance is poor, discipline weak and the hygienic conditions not up to the standard required.

The Department understands that Gabriel Syllieboy is truant officer for this reserve. You should immediately instruct him to take steps to increase the attendance at this school and also to see that the attendance is regular in future. The Department will be pleased to have a report from you in regard to general conditions at this school and you might state whether you consider it would be advisable to have a change in the teacher.
