



Ottawa, 15th November, 1919.

Madam:-

Referring to your letter of the 12th instant, I enclose herewith the accounts amounting respectively to \$29.00 and \$45.00 which you submitted from the General Hospital at Mattawa. The first account relates to the case of Mary Ann Francois alias Antoine, and the second is the case of Peter Pitchway. These accounts should be rendered in duplicate, and if, as would appear, the patients were attended by Dr. James, he should be requested to certify on the face of each account as to the correctness of the same. The accounts should then be forwarded to the Department. When the foregoing instructions are observed and the account again received, the matter of payment will be considered. When returning the account, be good enough to inform the Department on whose authority the Indians were placed in the Hospital. This information is also necessary before payment will be made.
