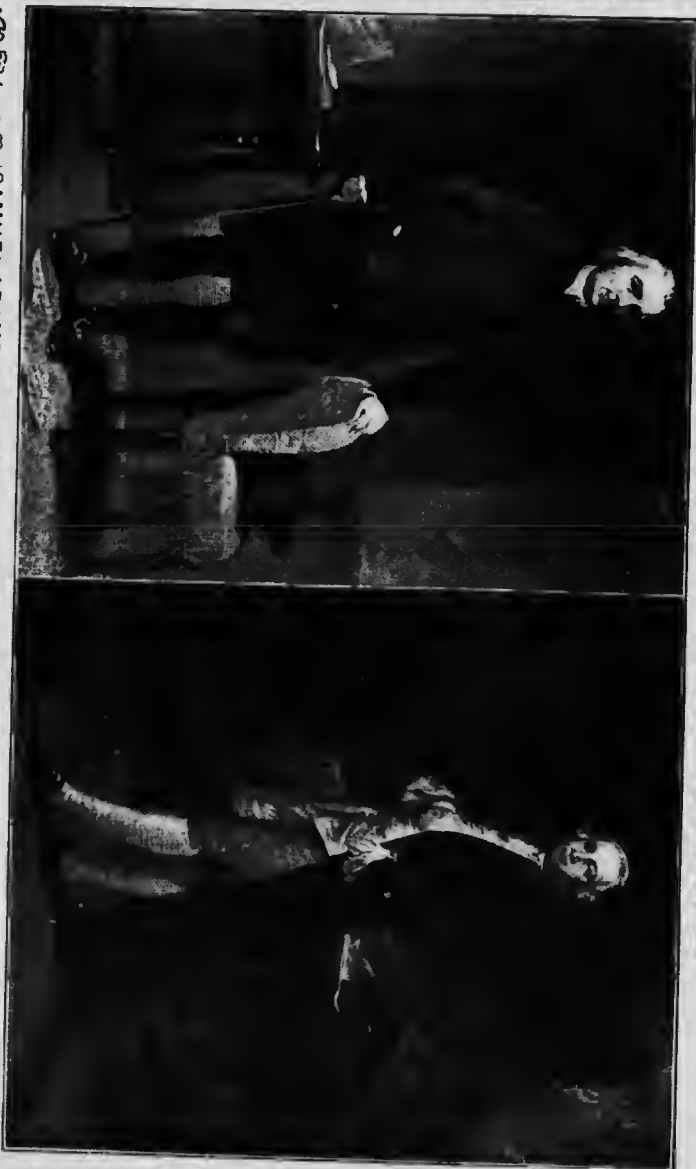




SAMUEL ADAMS AND JAMES OTIS ORATORS OF AMERICAN REVOLUTION
