" minster Hall. For the advancement of Justice in the mean time, in

" His Majesty's present Courts of King's Bench of Quebec and Mon-

" treat, and faving expence to Great-Britain and the Province. The

" faid Courts shall be in future, severally composed of the Chief Jus-

" tice of the Province and only two puisné Justices for the District of

" Quebec; and of the Chief Justice of Montreal and two puisné Justices

" only, for the District of Montreal, any Law to the contrary notwith-

" standing.

Mr. Papineau moved the previous question—That the question benow put? and was seconded by Mr. Martineau.

The House divided thereon, and the names were taken down as follows, viz.
