An Act to alter and amend an Act intituled "An Act for "regulating Innholders, Tavern-keepers and Retailers of Spirituous Liquors."

An Act to alter and amend an Act intituled "An Act for af-"certaining Damages on Protested Bills of Exchange."

An Act to continue an Act intituled "An Act for raising a "Revenue in this Province."

An Act in addition to an Act intituled "An Act for appoint" ing Commissioners of Sewers."

An Act for preserving the Bank of the River Saint John in front of the Parishes of Magerville, Sheffield and Waterborough—and—

An Act for appropriating and disposing of the Public Monies.

After which His Excellency was pleased to make the following fpeech to both Houses—

His Excellency's fpeech.

Gentlemen of the Council,

And Gentlemen of the Affembly,

"THE business before you being now finished as far as "the present circumstances seem to admit, I have the fatisfaction to dismiss you from further attendance at this time in General Assembly, in full considence that the provisions of this session will be found well adapted to the immediate exigencies of the public service; and that your respective exertions, for the eventual completion of every object conducive to the welfare and reputation of the province, will, at all times, be fully equal to the means and ability that your situation may supply."

General Assembly prorogued.

And then the Clerk of the Crown, by His Excellency's command, declared the General Assembly to be prorogued to the fecond Tuesday in June next.
