

## PROCLAMATION.

James Crowdy, (L.S.)

By His Honor James Crowdy, Esquire, Administrator of the Government of the Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies.

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Prorogued until Thursbay the Eighteenth day of September instant: And whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Thursbay the Twentieth day of November next ensuing:

I do, therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the *Twentieth* day of *November* next. Of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal at St. John's, in the aforesaid Island, the Eighth day of September, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-one, and in the Fifteenth Year of Her Majesty's Reign.
