SHIPPING SMELTS FROM THE WOODS

Dominion Fish Company Active
At The Loggieville
Branch

KEEN RIVALRY.

Tomcods Bring A Record Price
During Present
Season.

Mr. R. H. M. G. is managing of the Dominion Fish Company at Loggieville, shipping the best ear of smelts each week. This is the Company's best season in the fish business of the Miramichi. The rivalry between the towns is great and the fishmen already feel the benefit of the competition. The price of the smelts is kept up and the new company can take the credit of running the price of tomcods to the highest point ever reached in the Miramichi. At this date in former years tomcods could be bought for 25 cents to 40 cents a barrel, but today the fish fetch \$1.25 per barrel ready. The Company has already supplied several carloads of smelts from Chatham and Newcastle. A freezer and packing shed, 100x30 ft., has just been completed at Loggieville, and the Company also has a freez at Richibucto and Dalhousie.

Something Like Two Hundred
Shipped To St John This
Season.

But Vote Will Probably Not Be
Taken Until Next
March.

In order to get anything from an accurate estimation of the number of moose killed earlier in the year nothing of the other large game that have fallen victims to the sportsmen's rifles in the provinces of New Brunswick this year, it would be necessary to visit the premises of the taxidermists to the hunting camps, and to the hunting lodges and traps.

Mr. H. E. Thomas, pastor of the Methodist church, was the chairman of the


