MUSIC AND THE DRAMA.

"HANDS ACROSS THE SEA."
The attraction at the Grand Good Friday, matinee and night, and Saturday, matinee and night, will be "Hands Across the Sea." BERNHARDT IN "LA TOSCA."
Sarah Bernhardt's coming to London is really the most notable event in the history of the Opera House. The great French woman is popularly called the "Queen of the Stage," for surely no other actress has ever attempted so much on the highest artistic plane as she. Bernhardt's career, as detailed in a recently published book, is romance typified. One continuous succession of artistic triumphs—one sequence of conquests in the great world over which the muses preside—that is its gist and synopsis. She has ranged the world of comedy and the world of tragedy, and never yet found a role which taxed the full extent of her genius or the limitations of her art. But the world knows Bernhardt and her history. Her name is synonymous with "art," in its highest sense and application. Suffice it to say, Bernhardt is coming to London on Wednesday, April 8, and that she will play the title role in Sardou's great drama, "La Tosca."
That is all that is necessary.
