

ANOTHER ALASKA DISPUTE LIKELY

Ownership of a Stretch of 140 Miles Is Uncertain.

OWING TO THE LACK OF DATA

The Region Is of the Wildest and Is Destitute of Valuable Resources as Yet.

New York, Nov. 5. — The Sun, in a Washington dispatch says that an important fact in connection with the recent deliberations of the Alaskan boundary tribunal appeared yesterday, when it became known that a stretch of territory 140 miles in length and of uncertain width is still in dispute and is likely to remain for some time.

562 EMIGRANTS ABOARD

She brought 562 souls. They consist of Hungarians for Winnipeg, Regina, St. Paul, Chicago, and Sydney; Russians for Toronto, Montreal, Nebraska, Regina, Dakota, Winnipeg and North Dakota; Austrians for Winnipeg, Sifton, Lethbridge, Sydney, St. Louis, Edmonton, Rat Portage and Mooseley. There were also 1000 soldiers.
