He was 55 years old, a bachelor, and born in England. Mr. Puttill was the leading English delegate to the International

convention of the North American Young Men's Christian Association, held in November, 1907, in Washington.

## HAMILTON MAN WAS ELECTROCUTED

James Sayers Met Terribly Sudden Death While at Work.

Hamilton, Feb. 26. — The life of James Sayers, 316 Wilson street, was cut off with startling suddenness yesterday afternoon, when 10,000 volts of electricity passed through his body, throwing him from the top of a high

pole he was working on and killing him instantly. Sayers was working on the high voltage line between the transforming station and Decew Falls, where it passes Lottridge street, on the Grand Trunk right of way. Sayers was employed by the Dominion Power and Transmission Company as a patrolman.

The dead man was a brother of Detective Harry Sayers, of the local police force, and was 33 years of age. Eleven months ago he married, and in addition to his young widow leaves a child only a few weeks old.

The inquest was adjourned till next Tuesday evening.

The funeral will take place on Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, from the residence of his brother, Harry Sayers, 171 Robinson street.
