Twenty Cents a Basket and Six for a Dollar.

OATS ARE GOING UP

One Load of Extra Choice Sold for \$1.25 Per Cwt.—Hay Remains at \$13 Per Ton.

Oats on the local market are rapidly rising in price. Old oats rose as high as \$1.25 per cwt. this morning, and \$1.20 for extra choice. The market today was overclouded with tomatoes, which sold at 20 cents a basket, and even six baskets for \$1. Extra choice tomatoes were offered at 15 cents, but sold very slowly at this price.

Freestone peaches are now on the market, and sell at from 60 to 80 cents a basket.
