Bishop Clut, the Arctic regions missionary now in Montreal, furnishes the following interesting statistics of temperature observed at Good Hope during the years 1885 and 1886: From Oct. I, 1885, to May 1, 1886, the thermometer was never above zero. In February, 1886, it went down to 52 degrees below, and was as low as 18 degrees on May 10 of the same year, while on Oct. 24 preceding it was down to 27 degrees. Fourteen years ago Bishop Clut left ice on the Great Slave Lake on July 3, and afterward found ice again on the Mackenzie River, beyond the pellar circle as early as Sept. 17.
