The surroundings of both institutions has been improved from year to year and each season more attractive than the previous one. Their fronts have become quite models of landscape architecture and floral decorations. In our opinion this gardening work should be encouraged still more as it affords a pleasant out-door employment and diversion for both male and female inmates and would, in time, be enjoyed by all, to say nothing of its great benefits as a health restoring factor.

The Christmas festivities this year in both houses surpassed all previous efforts in that line and brought great pleasure to all. The extra work this must have given those in charge can scarcely be imagined, but seemed to be enjoyed equally by those that gave and those that received, and simply affords an illustration of the spirit that pervades this County institutions throughout the year, and we believe finds sympathy and response in every heart in the Municipality.

We can scarcely close without adding the regrets we felt to have to part with Mr. and Mrs. Love, who had given the County such valuable and faithful services at the Alms House and in charge of the farm for so many years, but their many friends will be glad to know that both of them have improved in health since their return to their former home.

Annapolis, N. S. In the Municipal Council, 1906. Council met in Bent's Hall, at Springfield in special session on Tuesday, the 31st day of July, A. D. 1906, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, pursuant to public notice given by W. G. Clarke, Warden of the Municipality of the County of Annapolis, as provided by the Statute in that behalf specifying the following objects, namely: 1st.
