Most rev Edouard Charles Fabre, born at
Montreal, 28th February, 1827; ordained priest
23rd February, 1850; elected bishop of Grati-
anopolis and coadjutor to His Lordship Ignace
Bourget, bishop of Montreal (*cum futura succe-
sione*), 1st April, 1873; consecrated at Montreal,
1st May, 1873; became bishop of Montreal, 11th
May, 1876 and Archbishop the 8th June, 1886.
