## Articla IV-of OFFICERS.

8. I. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Society. In his absenee the Vice-I'residents shall preside in their order. It shall be the duty of the President to deliver an address at the Ammal and Semi-A mual Meetings of the Society, or to make sume other provision for that purpose.
\& II. The Secretary shall have charge of the Arehives of the Society, kecp a record of its proceedings and a list of its members, and give notice of its meetings. He sha'l also make an annual report of the state of the funds of the suciety.
\% III. There skall be elected at each annual meeting, three Censors who shall examine applicants for membership and give ecrtificates, which shall entitle the applicant to a certiticate of membership on compliance with the foregoing provisions of the Constitution and loy-Laws, signed by the President and Secretary of this Society, and for which he slanll pay the sum of five shillings eurrency.

## Article V.-OF AMENDMENTS.

\% I. The By-Laws may be amended by a majority of the members presont at any annual meeting.
