

the name, age, residence, the date of the license and other medical qualifications of every person who may be entitled to be registered, and the places and names of the institutions at which he shall have obtained his degrees or diplomas, and he shall from time to time make the necessary alterations in the addresses or qualifications of the persons registered. The Registrar shall be the keeper of the seal of the College.

XI. The Registrar shall also keep a book in which shall be entered the name, age, place of birth and residence of every person about to enter upon the study of medicine who shall have passed the preliminary examination instituted by the Examiners appointed by the Board; and also another book in which shall be registered the name, age, place of birth and residence, date of license and other medical qualifications of all women complying with the requirements of the Board respecting the practice of Midwifery in this Province.

XII. All the above books or registers shall at all times be open and subject to inspection by any duly registered practitioner or by any other person.

XIII. It shall be the duty of the Registrar to collect from the members of the College their annual contributions and their registration fees, and to pay over to the Treasurer, monthly, all the monies belonging to the College that he may have received.

XIV. The Registrar shall, when directed by the Board cause to be printed and distributed to the members of the College, a correct copy of the Register of the names in alphabetical order according to the surname, with the respective residences, in the form set forth in schedule A, or to the like effect, together with the medical titles, diplomas and qualifications conferred by any authorized body, with the date thereof of all persons appearing in "the Register" as existing on the day of publication; and such Register shall be called the "Quebec Medical Register."

XV. The Registrar shall receive as remuneration the sum of \$150 annually out of the funds of the College.
