BOND OF SECRETARY TO TRUSTEES.

The following is the proper form of bond:
PROVINCE OF NOVA SCOTIA.

Know all men by these Presents, That we, (name of Secretary,) as principal, and (name of sureties,) as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto our Sovereign Lady Victoria, by the grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, &c., in the sum of..... of lawful money of Nova Scotia, to be paid to our said Lady, the Queen, her heirs and successors, for the true payment whereof, we bind ourselves, and each of us by himself, for the whole and every part thereof, and the heirs, executors and administrators of us and each of us, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, and dated this..... day of..... in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and..... and in the..... year of Her Majesty's reign.

Whereas, the said..... has been duly appointed to be Secretary to the Board of Trustees of..... School Section, No..... in the District of.....

Now the condition of this Obligation is such, That if the said (name of Secretary) do and shall from time to time, and at all times hereafter, during his continuance in the said office, well and faithfully perform all such acts and duties as do or may hereafter appertain to the said office, by virtue of any law of this Province, in relation to the said office of Secretary to Trustees, and shall in all respects conform to and observe all such rules, orders, or regulations as are now or may be from time to time established for or in respect of the said office, and shall well and faithfully keep all such accounts, books and papers as are or may be required to be kept by him in his said office, and shall in all respects well and faithfully perform and execute the duties of the said office; and if on ceasing to hold the said office, he shall forthwith, on demand, hand over to the Trustees of the said School Section, or to his successor in office, all books, papers, moneys, accounts, and other property in his possession by virtue of his said office of Secretary—then the said obligation to be void—otherwise to be and continue in full force and virtue.

(FORM OF AGREEMENT.)

Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into the..... day of..... A. D., 18....., between (name of teacher) a duly licensed teacher of the..... class of the one part, and (names of trustees) Trustees of School Section No..... in the district of..... of the second part.

The said (name of teacher) on his (or her) part, in consideration of the below mentioned agreements by the parties of the second part, hereby covenants and agrees with the said (names of trustees) Trustees as aforesaid and their successors in office, diligently and faithfully to teach a public school in the said section under the authority of the said Trustees and their successors in office, during the School Year (or Term) ending on the 31st day of October next, (or the thirtieth day of April, as the case may be.)

And the said Trustees and their successors in office on their part covenant and agree with the said (name of teacher) Teacher as aforesaid, to pay the said (name of teacher) out of the School Funds under their control, at the rate of..... dollars for the School Year (or Term.)

And it is further mutually agreed that both parties to this agreement shall be in all respects subject to the provisions of the School Law and the Regulations made under its authority by the Council of Public Instruction.

NOTICE.

- 1.—The County Fund is paid to the Trustees of the section.
- 2.—Teachers must engage with Trustees at a definite sum or rate. The Provincial Grant is paid to Teachers in addition to such specified sum.
- 3.—The Provincial Grant to County Academies is paid to the Trustees. Principals of County Academies should engage with Trustees for the full sum which they are to receive as salary.
- 4.—Each Inspector is instructed to report every case of illegal stipulation on the part of Teachers in reference to the County Fund.

On Receipt of this Journal the Secretary to Trustees will at once inform the Teacher of its receipt and place it at his disposal for reference.
