The publishers of The National Magazine have acquired Magazine of American History, which was edited by Mrs. Martha I. Lamb until her death on January 3rd last. With the February issue these two leading historical journals are merged into one, and the name, Magazine of American History, that of the older periodical, now in its 29th volume, is retained.

"La Tour and Acadia" embraces one of the most interesting episodes in the history both of Massachusetts and Nova Scotia.
