AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA FOR THE TRAINING IN CANADA OF PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF JAMAICA

THE GOVERNMENT of Canada and the Government of Jamaica hereinafter referred to as Canada and Jamaica respectively,

CONSIDERING that Jamaica has requested Canada to provide training in Canada for personnel of the armed forces of Jamaica,

HAVE AGREED as follows:

ARTICLE 1

Definitions

In this Agreement

- (a) "trainee" means a member of the armed forces of Jamaica who has been authorized by his government to undergo training in Canada with the Canadian Forces and who has been accepted by Canada for training; and
- (b) "training" means the military training prescribed by the Chief of the Defence Staff of the Canadian Forces.

ARTICLE 2

Training and Costs

Subject to terms and conditions of this Agreement, Canada shall provide training in Canada for trainees in such numbers as may from time to time be agreed upon by the appropriate authorities of Jamaica and Canada.

ARTICLE 3

Unless other arrangements are made for particular courses of training, costs shall be borne as follows:

- (a) Canada shall bear the cost of:
 - (i) the allowances mentioned in subparagraphs (b)(iii) and (iv) of article 4,
 - (ii) tuition, clothing and equipment required for training, and all other training costs,
 - (iii) rations and quarters,
 - (iv) duty travel in connection with the training, and
