(A) INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS AND AGREEMENTS.

Agreements Concluded

- (i) Ottawa, August 17, 1945 - between Canada and the United Kingdom, with respect to the loan to the Government of the United Kingdom of vessels owned by the Government of Canada. This Agreement is deemed to have been made as of December 3, 1943.
- (ii) Ottawa, August 17, 1945 - between Canada and the United Kingdom supplemental to the foregoing.
- (iii) Ottawa, August 17, 1945 - between Canada and Australia with respect to the loan to the Government of Australia of vessels owned by the Government of Canada.

(B) PUBLICATIONS.

1. Treaty Series, 1945, No.7 - Charter of the United Nations, including the Statute of the International Court of Justice, together with the Interim Arrangements establishing the Preparatory Commission of the United Nations, signed at San Francisco, June 26, 1945.

(C) COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES
IN CANADA.

1. On August 13, H.E. Pedro Castelblanco Aguero, the Ambassador for Chile, presented his Letter of Credence to the Governor-General. (Press Release No.55, August 13).
2. On August 20, the French Embassy announced that Major MacMahon had ceased to act as both Military and Air Attache and that while he retained the duties of Air Attache Lt. Col. Henri Mesnet had been appointed Military Attache.
3. On August 27, Mr. Martin Luis Drago assumed his duties as First Secretary at the Argentine Embassy.
4. On August 28, Mr. John Hearne, High Commissioner for Ireland in Canada returned to Ireland until October 1. In his absence Mr. Conway will be Acting High Commissioner.
5. In August Mr. F.E. Cumming-Bruce, Assistant Secretary in the United Kingdom High Commissioner's Office, returned to England.
6. During August Mr. Humberto Branes arrived in Ottawa to take up his duties as Secretary at the Chilean Embassy.
