Sir:

As Chairman of the Committee appointed by the President of The University of British Columbia to consider the military policy of that University, I have the honour to request information on the following points:

- (1) Is there an O.T.C. at McGill University? *yes*
- (2) If so is membership compulsory? *No.*
- (3) Are any inducements, either financial or academic, offered to students enrolling in the corps? *No.*
- (4) What proportion of the students join the corps? *about 5 or 6%*
- (5) Are any military courses given at the University in connection with the O.T.C.?
- (6) Are such courses given any value as part of a student's qualification for a degree? *No*
- (7) What proportion of students take such courses?
- (8) Are all arms represented in the O.T.C.? *Infantry & mt Inf.*
- (9) What is their comparative popularity? *mt Inf.*
- (10) Of the Commissioned Ranks, what proportion of them, if any, are confined to members of the University Staff? *None*
- (11) Generally, what are the aims and ambitions of the corps?
