



This is a favorite plan for a two room school where it may be necessary to increase the capacity in the future, which as shown can be done very economically and without interfering with existing building. This plan has probably been adopted in more instances than any other plan illustrated herewith and has given exceptional satisfaction. Although a flat roof is shown a sloping roof has been used in many cases. The class rooms, cloak rooms, etc. are of standard size and proportion, and well lighted and ventilated. The hall and stairs are commodious and ample for a four room school. The teacher's room is a decided advantage in this plan.
