

V PARTIE—SIMPLIFICATION

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Exercice I.

$$1. \frac{3 \times 4}{2 \times 3} = \frac{2}{1} = 2$$

$$2. \frac{4 \times 8}{6 \times 2} = \frac{8}{3} = 2\frac{2}{3}$$

$$3. \frac{6 \times 7}{3 \times 2} = \frac{7}{1} = 7$$

$$4. \frac{9 \times 6}{2 \times 3} = \frac{9}{1} = 9$$

$$5. \frac{6 \times 6}{6 \times 6} = \frac{1}{1} = 1$$

$$6. \frac{8 \times 2}{4 \times 6} = \frac{2}{3}$$

Exercice II.

$$1. \frac{2 \times 4 \times 8}{4 \times 2 \times 6} = \frac{4}{3} = 1\frac{1}{3}$$

$$2. \frac{3 \times 7 \times 9}{6 \times 7 \times 3} = \frac{3}{2} = 1\frac{1}{2}$$

$$3. \frac{6 \times 8 \times 9}{9 \times 4 \times 2} = \frac{6}{1} = 6$$

$$4. \frac{1 \times 9 \times 8}{8 \times 3 \times 1} = \frac{3}{1} = 3$$

$$5. \frac{2 \times 6 \times 9}{2 \times 4 \times 6} = \frac{9}{4} = 2\frac{1}{4}$$

$$6. \frac{6 \times 8 \times 9}{3 \times 4 \times 3} = \frac{12}{1} = 12$$
