The Librarian is authorized to subscribe for such newspapers published in the Province, and other papers, British or Foreign, and procure the continuance of such periodical works as may be from time to time directed by the Speaker.

During the Recess of Parliament, no Member of the House shall be at liberty to borrow, or have in his possession at any one time, more than three works from the Library, or to retain the same for a longer period than one mouth. That no Books of Reference, or books of special cost or value, may be removed from the Seat of Government under any circumstances.

That, at the first meeting of the Library Committee, at every Session of Parliament, the Librarian shall report a list of books absent at the commencement of the Session, specifying the names of any person who may have retained the same, in contravention of either of the foregoing Rules.
