TWO TRAINS COLLIDE ON A HIGH TRESTLE IN BRITISH COLUMBIA.

Supr. Fisher of the Alexandria Mines Was Killed—Engineer Samuel Walton of Toronto and Two Others Also Went to Death.

Victoria, B.C., Sept. 15.—(Special).—Two trains, one from Lynton and No. 10 from Alexandria, collided on this morning about two miles north of Lynton on the Esquimalt and Nanaimo Railway. The trains approached the bridge on both sides in a sharp incline coming suddenly off the level of the bridge, which lies at the bottom of the cut.

The cause of the accident was a misplaced signal. Superintendent Fisher's wife and family were on the train.

When the new engine signalled another train to proceed, the latter was too far west and both smashed together with tremendous force right in the middle of the trestle, one train toppling over into the ravine below.

Fisher and Walton were killed on the spot. The other two men died a few minutes later in the hospital.

A wrecking train was despatched from Lynton within an hour of receiving the news with a strong force of men and several pieces of heavy machinery.

The news has caused great excitement here, where all the killed were well known.
