

MOTION PICTURE MEN ORGANIZE

Exhibitors From All Over Ontario Form Protective Association.

ONE CENSORSHIP BOARD

Believe Films Should Be Passed by Body of Qualified Officials.

Organizing for the purpose of preventing the government from passing legislation affecting motion picture shows without a report from their viewpoint, the Ontario Motion Picture Protective Association, at its last meeting in Cooper's Dining Hall, Queen street and Spadina avenue, yesterday afternoon, selected Arthur Cohen of Toronto as its president, and named other officers.

All of the officers are the most influential in the industry in Ontario. The greatest enthusiasm was exhibited at the meeting. Speeches by various members were delivered, and all of them condemned past procedure in the passing of laws, and held that only one censorship board in Canada was necessary.

Mr. Cohen declared that the whole censorship system in Ontario was wrong and that it should be replaced by one Dominion board of well qualified, high-salaried censors. He said if the industry was to occupy a place second only to that of the press as an instrument of progress and enlightenment, pictures must be judged by high-minded and intelligent censors.

"Joker" Clauses. In denouncing "joker" clauses in the blue book of laws under which exhibitors show motion pictures, P. Kaufman declared that if fees were increased in Ontario, cost of service in the theatres would be increased.

W. A. Bach said that the exhibitors did not object to paying a fair share of taxes, but did resent compulsory payment of the cost of service in national matters, to have and to hold the confidence of government officials and to have the strength to prove its contention on any question, and enforce its decision. P. J. Nolan of Ottawa, and William Barrett of Toronto, discussed organization work.

An enthusiastic reception was given Mayor T. L. Church, who delivered a brief address of welcome. He paid a tribute to the work of the exhibitors in aiding recruiting, and declaring that they had always co-operated with the police commissioners and the military authorities in London, and an exchange man, president.

Officers Elected. The exchange men, some of whom took an initial part in organizing the exhibitors, were well represented. They will be represented on the board of managers. The full list of officers are as follows: President, Arthur Cohen; vice-president, P. J. Nolan of Ottawa; secretary, W. A. Bach of Toronto; honorary treasurer, Minnebeck of London; and treasurer, Mr. Brady, sr. The board is composed of George Phillips, Kitchener; Edward Bernard, London; W. H. Regan, Lindsay; P. J. Bardsley, Timmins; Frank Guest, Hamilton; J. H. Bruck, Penbrooke; B. Burnside, Colingwood; and the following Toronto men: E. L. Ruddy, Mr. Burnstein, Dr. Richardson, M. Gebirg, John Griffin, Bert Applegarth, Jerry Shea, L. Robson, G. Wolman, and W. P. Sexton, besides three exchange men yet to be named.

Board of Education Will Decide as to Advances at Next Meeting.

WANT TRIBUNALS IN EACH DISTRICT

Conference Proposes That Overseas Men Be Selected From Militia.

OPINION UNANIMOUS

No Dissent to Suggestion That Government Should Enforce Militia Act.

That some form of compulsion was necessary to enable the troops of the C.E.F., now in Canada, to proceed overseas and to replace them with militia, the militia act, appeared to be the unanimous opinion at the big military recruiting conference held in the main hall of the College street, yesterday morning and afternoon.

It was attended by Major-General G. Gwatkins, chief of the general staff; Major-General W. E. Edgington, adjutant-general, and 200 commanding officers of the C.E.F. and militia units.

Major-General W. A. Logie presided. It was also unanimously stated that voluntary enlistment was at an end, and that the draft system (outlined in a message from Ottawa a few days ago), was not practical.

The conference asked for an order in council by Ottawa, enforcing the Militia Act, and that the militia units be mobilized for service. In the event of this being done, the first-class called out "compulsory males of 18 years and upward, but under 30, who are unmarried or widowers without children."

Tribunals Suggested. It was suggested that a judicial tribunal be appointed by the government in each territorial tribunal area to make the selection of men to be called out, and to decide whether they should go or not. This was also made unanimous by the conference.

The staff officers from Ottawa seemed impressed with the unanimous view of the Toronto district commanders viewed the situation, and said they would convey these views to the militia department.

It is pointed out that if the Militia Act were put into force the 22 militia regiments of this divisional area alone would be a "war-strength" force.
