the words "and resident in the Diocese" after the words "licensed by the Bishop."

Carried by a majority of both Orders. Moved by Mr. G. A. Schofield, seconded by Rev. H. H. Barber,

That Article XIV. of the Constitution be amended by adding the words "the Bishop Coadjutor" after the words "when the Bishop is not present," and the same words after the words "and in case of the absence of," and omitting the word "both."

Carried by a majority of both Orders. The above three resolutions stand over for confirmation at

the next annual meeting of the Synod.

Moved by Rev. T. E. Dowling, seconded by Rev. T. Neales, That the thanks of this Synod be rendered to the Railway and Steamboat Companies that have extended courtesies to Carried.

Moved by Rev. G. G. Roberts, seconded by Mr. G. E. Fenety, In Article II. of the Constitution, to strike out the words "and residents" to "attendants," and substitute the words "and at least one lay representative from each parish shall be resident in the parish for which he is elected, or a stated attendant at some church or chapel-of-ease within the same."

Moved in amendment by Mr. G. A. Schofield, seconded by Mr. E. Willis,

That the consideration of this question be postponed to the next session of the Synod. Carried.

Mr. E. B. Chandler, seconded by Mr. G. A. Schofield, moved the following addition to Article III. of the Constitution:

That in order to entitle a substitute to sit in this Synod, the inability of the regularly elected delegate to attend shall be certified by the Rector or Missionary in charge to the Secretary of the Synod, before such substitute takes his seat.

Carried by a majority of both Orders.

This resolution stands over for confirmation to the next annual meeting.

On motion, a vote of thanks was passed to the Secretary, the Rev. Canon Partridge, for his services.
