

BYE-LAWS

OF THE

HOME FOR THE AGED.

1. The officers of the "Home" shall be a President, Secretary and Treasurer, who shall be elected at each Annual Meeting, and they together with eighteen other ladies shall constitute the Committee of Management, seven of whom shall be a quorum.

2. The Annual Meeting shall be held in the month of July, at which meeting the report of the treasurer and of the Committee shall be presented.

3. Any vacancy occurring either in the Board of Trustees or in the Committee during the year, may be filled at any meeting of the General Committee.

4. Whereas this Institution is more especially designed for those who from reduced circumstances are compelled to seek a home in old age, every application for admission must be made in writing, stating the temporal circumstances and age of the applicant.

5. No person shall be admitted who has not attained the age of 60 years unless under special circumstances, by vote of the General Committee.

6. Persons admitted from the City of Halifax shall pay sixty dollars per annum, and from the country seventy dollars per annum, payable half-yearly in advance. In each case two persons (to be approved of by the Committee) shall guarantee the payments of the required sums in writing in the following form:

"We promise to pay the Secretary of the "Home for the Aged" the sum of _____ dollars per annum, half-yearly in advance for _____ so long as she may continue an inmate of the "Home."
