

## THE FATE OF THE ARISTOCRACY OF OLD RUSSIA

Warsaw, Feb. 12.—(Associated Press Correspondence).—Driven from palace to palace, some of the members of the aristocracy of old Russia now are peeling potatoes or chopping wood here for a living.

## SAYS CAPTAIN PERRY WAS IN FEAR OF DEATH

Neighbor Testifies Yarmouth Victim Had Told of Previous Attempts on Life.

(Canadian Press Despatch). Yarmouth, N. S., March 1.—A man continually haunted by the threat of a violent ending to his life drama, suffering from an inexplicable premonition that he would be poisoned; a man whose life had been twice menaced in insidious ways by an unknown foe; a man whose domestic life was not ideal, and who entered the glow of happier hours first as a man was the late Captain George Perry, according to the sensational testimony of a neighbor and friend at the inquest into Perry's murder tonight.

The neighbor was Thomas Nickerson, at whose house the murdered man had spent his last evening of life, and to whom Captain Perry had often indirectly expressed his fear of foul play and told of two previous efforts to take him out of the way, once by poisoned cake, the second time through laquer with his collar studs. Nickerson also spoke of the domestic life of the Perrys; of the separation between the children and his wife and their later reconciliation; of Perry's wishful longing for a home that was happy. An arrest is expected soon, according to Inspector Kennedy.

## KING NICHOLAS DIES IN FRANCE

Aged Monarch of Montenegro Had Been in Exile From Troubled Country.

(Canadian Press Despatch). Antwerp, France, March 1.—King Nicholas, of Montenegro, died here today.

Nicholas I of Montenegro was born in October, 1841. He was proclaimed Prince of Montenegro as successor to his uncle Danilo I in 1860 and assumed the title of King under a resolution passed unanimously by the national Skupstina in 1910, on the occasion of the fifteenth anniversary of his accession. During the war Montenegro participated on the side of the Allies. When the armistice was signed the Serbians ordered elections for the national assembly and when the assembly met in 1918 it declared itself in favor of the deposition of Nicholas and the reigning dynasty.

An Exile in France.

Shortly afterwards the assembly voted for the union of Montenegro with the Jugoslav state of the Kingdom of Serbs, Croats and Slovenes. Nicholas and his cabinet since that time have been in France and had decided as to the status of Montenegro lies with the peace conference.

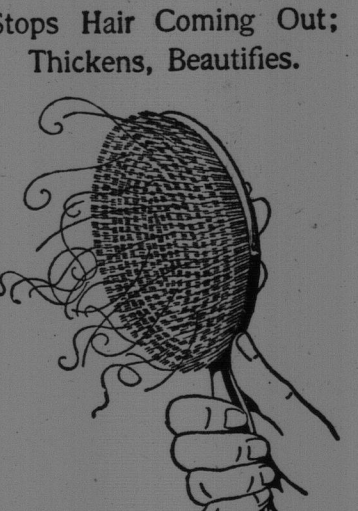

## FATAL DUEL IN KENTUCKY TOWN

Man Who Resisted Arrest Killed — Deputy Sheriff Mortally Wounded.

Lexington, Ky., March 2.—While scores of people stood at a comparatively safe distance to watch the battle, Deputy Sheriff John Smith of Hazard, Perry county, Ky., and Kelly Robinson, a professional "bad man" who had terrorized parts of the Kentucky mountains for years, fought a duel at Hazard with pistols, that resulted in the death of Robinson and the fatal wounding of Smith.

The duel followed the attempted arrest of Robinson, who was thirty years old, by Smith, who is twenty-two, being the youngest deputy sheriff in the state. Robinson had just been paroled from the penitentiary, where he was serving a term for murder. He reached Hazard and invaded his brother John's restaurant, where, with drawn pistol, he created terror among the diners and threatened to shoot them.

Officers ordered him to leave town and a squad escorted him to the outskirts. Robinson later came back into the town by a different route and met Smith in the street. Smith started to shoot at Robinson and he began firing. Smith replied promptly. Robinson got first blood and shot Smith twice. Smith put two bullets into Robinson, with both men still on their feet. Then Smith got in a third shot and Robinson fell dead. Smith then collapsed and it was found that he was mortally wounded.
