Princess Alice, for Pacific Coast Service, Now on Way Around Horn

Montreal, Sept. 26—There will be soon put into commission, by the Canadian Pacific Railway, in its Pacific coast service, a new steamship, the Princess Alice. It will probably be put in the Vancouver-Victoria-Seattle triangular run. The new boat was built by Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd., Newcastle-on-Tyne was launched May 20 and is now on its way to Vancouver around Cape Horn.

In addition to the ordinary coal bunkers the ship will carry fuel oil and the boiler will be fitted with a complete installation of oil burning apparatus.
