The number of deaths during the year is not as great as in some years preceding, but the obituary list is sadly remarkable for the prominence, influence, and usefulness of most of the deceased, and the startling suddenness with which some of them were called away. Time is rapidly removing the old landmarks of our congregation and changing its aspect. Patriarchs and matrons, young men and maidens, loved ones and beloved have been removed from our hearts and homes. How emphatic the warning—"Be ye also ready."
