Synopsis of Canadian North- west Land Regulations

Any person who is the sole head of
a family, or any male over 18 years old,
may homestead a quarter-section of
available Dominion land in Manitoba,
Saskatchewan or Alberta. The ap-
plicant must appear in person at the Do-
minion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency
for the district. Entry by proxy may
be made at any agency, on certain
conditions, by father, mother, son,
daughter, brother or sister of intend-
ing homesteader.

Duties - Six months' residence upon
and cultivation of the land in each of
three years. A homesteader may live
within nine miles of his homestead on
a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned
and occupied by him or by his
father, mother, son, daughter, brother
or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in
good standing may pre-empt a quar-
ter-section of land at homestead.
Price \$100 per acre. Duties - Must re-
side six months in each of six years
from date of homestead entry (includ-
ing the time required to earn homestead
patent) and cultivate fifty acres
extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted
his homestead right cannot obtain a
pre-emption right. A homesteader
homesteaded in certain districts. Price
\$100 per acre. Duties - Must re-
side six months in each of six years,
cultivate fifty acres and erect a house
worth \$500.00.
