stood against the foe. Once more British came to her assistance and gave as generously of her strength as circumstances would permit.

Command of the sea made it possible for this assistance to be sent to Canada. Had the strength of Britain's navy been broken, the Canadian militia, standing alone, would have been overwhelmed by an enemy so numerically superior as was the army of the United States in 1812-14.

Writing of Conditions prevailing when the war broke out, the historian Bradley, in 'The Making of Canada,' mentions that the sea was to be apprehended. The British navy, having destroyed its rivals, had deteriorated somewhat from this very reason.

Conditions in Inland Waters. Going on to describe conditions on the inland waters of Canada, Bradley writes: 'One serious naval oversight however, had been committed in failing to place a sufficient fleet on Lakes Ontario and Erie.'

When, late in the autumn of 1775, Montgomery and his army of invaders sailed down the St. Lawrence, it was as if they existed, with the exception of a little town that crowned the heights of Quebec, in possession of the American army.

Eight months before the enemy had had shut him in, Carleton had sent home to England urgent despatches calling for supplies and reinforcements.
