His Excellency proposed to the Council, for adoption, the following Ordinances, which being severally read, were agreed to unanimously.

An Ordinance to make provision for defraying the Civil Expenditure of the Provincial Government from the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, to the tenth day of October of the same year.

An Ordinance to make good two certain sums of money therein mentioned, advanced in payment of certain indispensable expenses of the Civil Government of Lower Canada, between the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, and the thirty first day of October of the same year.

An Ordinance to appropriate certain sums, annually, to enable Her Majesty to defray the expense of Pensions conferred on the Honorable Jonathan Sewell, Esquire, and the Honorable James Reid, Esquire.

The Council then adjourned.
