The Toronto and York Radial Railway Company

- The Radial lines of Toronto are operated east, west and north from the city.
- The Metropolitan Division runs north for 52 miles to Jackson's Point on Lake Simcoe—a delightful summer resort. This line serves and connects the towns of Thornhill, Richmond Hill, Aurora, Newmarket, Queensville, Keswick, and Roach's Point, and gives the farmers first-class service throughout this whole district. Eighteen miles from the city is a beautiful Park and Lake of 200 acres—Bond Lake, and its natural surroundings in the shape of trees, hills and water-courses make it especially attractive.
- To the west the Mimico Division runs for 10 miles along the Lake Shore, touching Mimico, New Toronto, the popular Long Branch Summer Resort, to Port Credit on the Credit River—well known as a fishing and boating place.
- The Scarboro Division extends for 10 miles along the noted Scarboro bluffs—famous for their remarkable geological features. It touches the town of East Toronto, and runs through the agricultural township of Scarboro to Highland Creek.
